

Information to Send With Your Rooflight Blind Enquiry

Use this checklist when preparing an enquiry, quotation request or design-team review for a commercial rooflight blind system.



Sending clear project information helps speed up specification advice, system selection and quotation accuracy.



1. Drawings

- ☐ Rooflight drawings
- ☐ Plans, sections and elevations



2. Dimensions

- ☐ Confirmed opening and glazing dimensions
- ☐ Overall glazing dimensions



3. Photographs

- ☐ Current rooflight photographs
- ☐ Surrounding area and access photos



4. Glazing geometry

- ☐ Glazing angle and shape
- ☐ Blind drawing direction



5. Performance requirements

- ☐ Required glare, heat and daylight control
- ☐ Blackout or privacy requirements



6. Fabric and appearance

- ☐ Preferred fabric
- ☐ Colour or appearance preferences



7. Controls and electrical

- ☐ Manual or motorised operation
- ☐ BMS, DALI, KNX or sensor requirements



8. Fixings and surrounding construction

- ☐ Fixing substrate and supporting steelwork
- ☐ Ceiling details and nearby building services



9. Site and programme

- ☐ Access restrictions and working height
- ☐ Project programme and site location



Useful Note

Early-stage drawings may be enough for initial guidance. Final manufacture will normally require verified dimensions, approved drawings, confirmed fixing details and electrical information.
